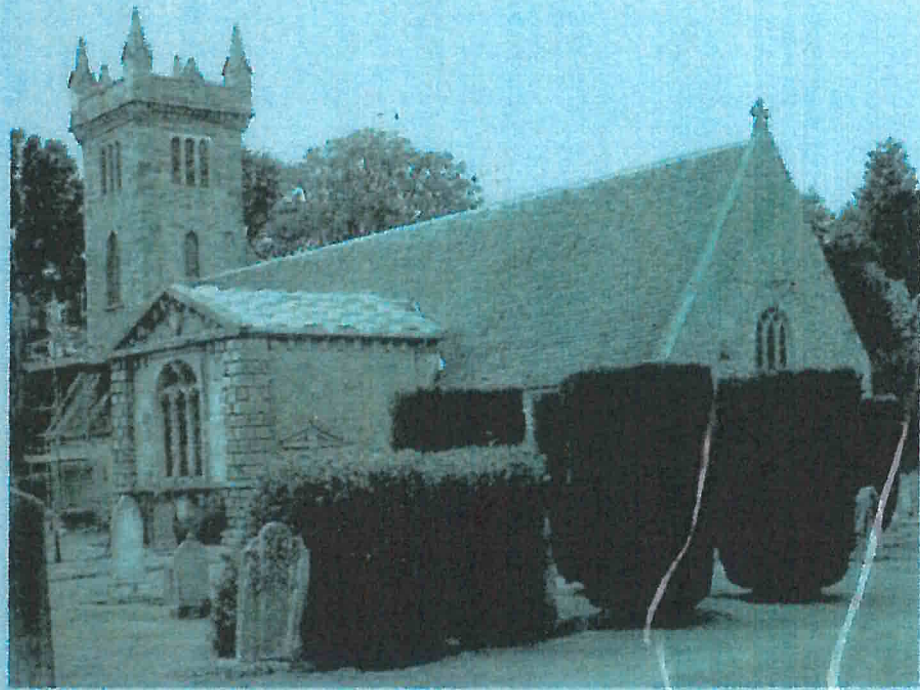
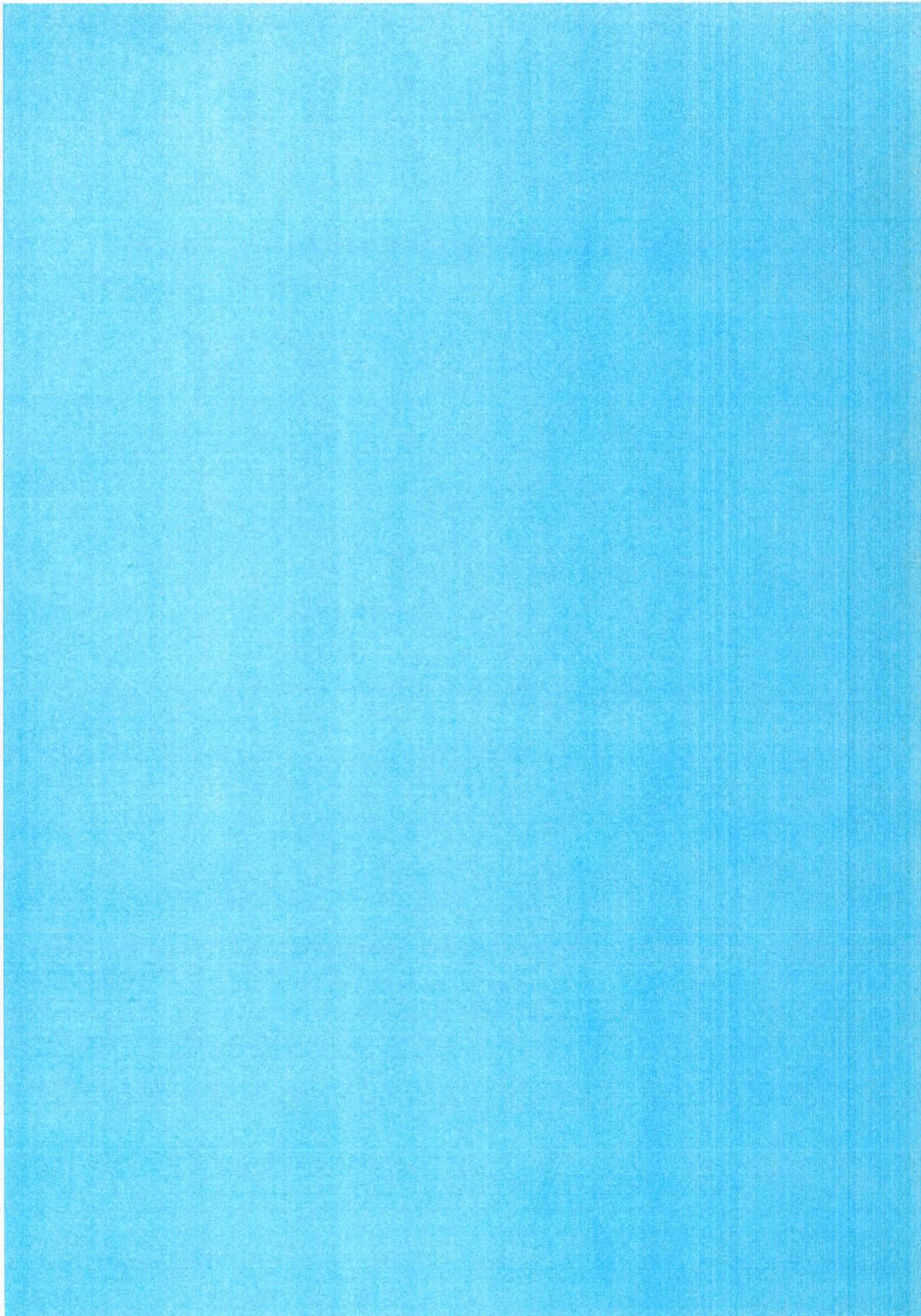

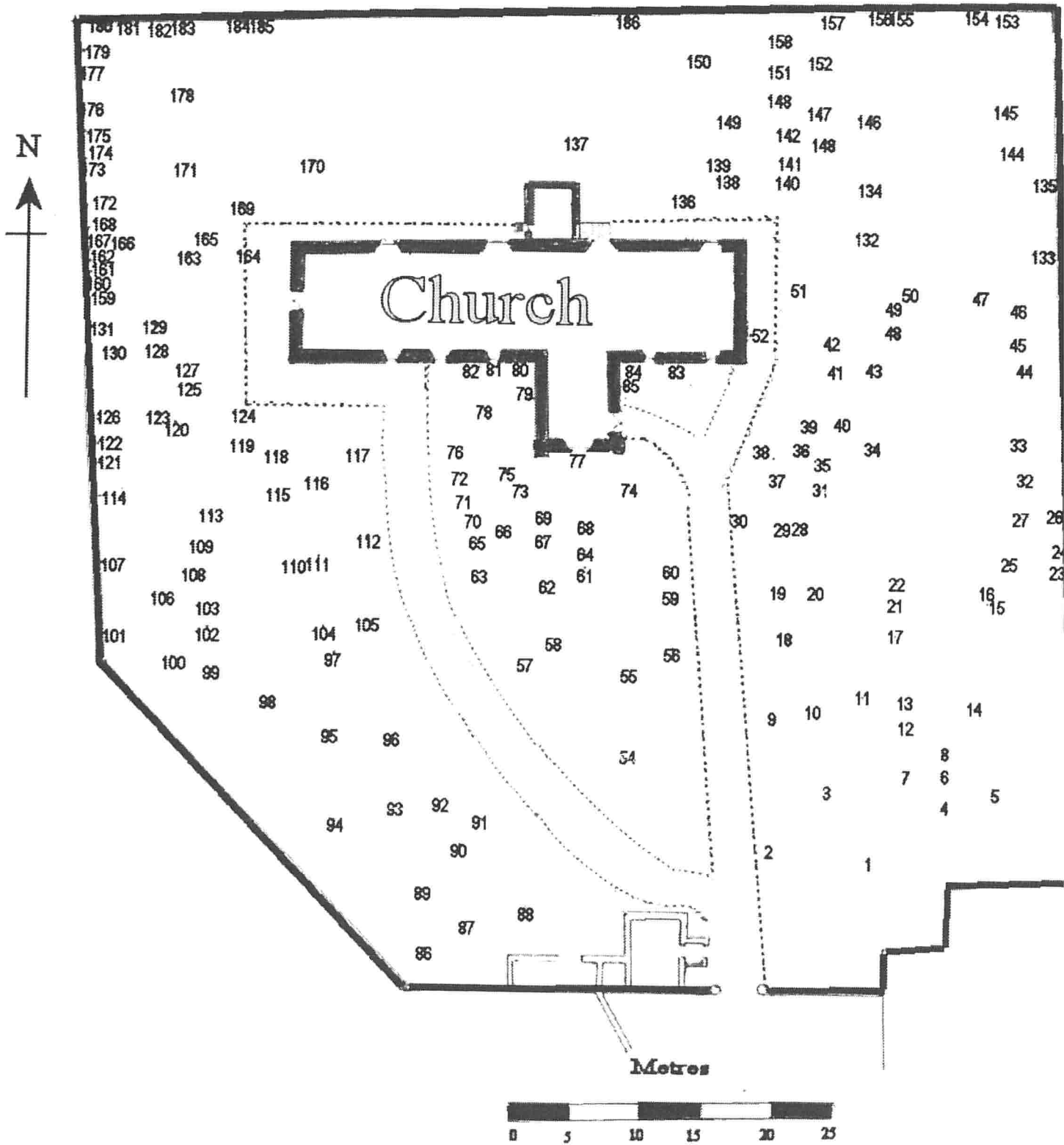
Preface
