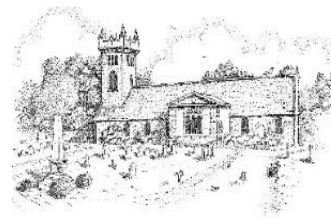

The Abbey and Dirleton Kirk Sessions will consider whether or not to depart from the historic position of the Church of Scotland on marriage, that is, whether or not to allow applications from ministers in a same-sex marriage or civil partnership.

TAG - "Operation Hope" with James Fraser

Tuesday Afternoon Group welcomes James Fraser who will talk about Release International's project "Operation Hope" on the 10th February at 2:00pm in Abbey large hall. Release International is a UK based Christian charity, supporting believers around the world who are persecuted for

Christ and the gospel. The Operation Hope project aims to support 2000 people in around 100 villages in Upper Egypt. It is hoped that money raised will support multiple practical needs so that the Christian community in this area will be strengthened and enabled to flourish. 1 Corinthians 2:1-12

When I came to you, brothers, I did not come with eloquence or superior wisdom as I proclaimed to you the testimony about God. For I resolved to know nothing while I was with you except Jesus Christ and him crucified. I came to you in weakness and fear, and with much trembling. My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a demonstration of the Spirit's power, so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power.

We do, however, speak a message of wisdom among the mature, but not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. No, we speak of God's secret wisdom, a wisdom that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began. None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory. However, as it is written:

"What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love him" - but God has revealed to us by his Spirit.

The Spirit searches all things, even the deep things of God. For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the man's spirit within him? In the same way no one knows the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God. We have not received the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may understand what God has freely given us.
